# GENERAL INFORMATION AND SALE NOTES

## LOCATION

The sale will be held at Worcester Livestock Market, Nunnery Way, Worcester.

M5, Junction 6 – take the A4538 signposted Evesham, approx ½ mile you arrive at second roundabout, turn right, signposted Hospital A&E and city centre. Follow road going over motorway and you will see the market on the left. When you get to the next roundabout turn left and the market entrance is 300 metres on the left.

From Herefordshire – A44/A4103 to A4440 ring road, turn right going round Worcester following signs towards M5, when arriving at roundabout at top of hill, take left turn now following signs to Hospital A&E, still on the A4440 ring road. At the next roundabout turn right onto Swinesherd Way, follow dual carriageway, straight over first roundabout. You will notice the market on the right hand side, proceed right round the second roundabout, coming back on yourself, the entrance to the market is approx 300 metres on your left.

## EASYCARE SHEEP

Easy Care are the ideal low cost meat sheep for the modern farmer.

EasyCares have a high killing out %. The meat is of the highest quality, light in texture, fine grained, lean and tasty.

No shearing or crutching and low propensity for disease minimise veterinary and shepherding costs. They are hornless, extremely hardy and require little maintenance and seasonally shed their short kempy fleece.

Ease of lambing is a major feature of the breed. Lambing % will vary depending on the farm system and management. 140% on the hard hill and 200% plus on strong lowland farms is not unknown.

EasyCare Ewes milk well and are excellent mothers. Lambs are active and alert at birth and grow quickly in most conditions.

EasyCare Rams are virile, hardy with a long active lifespan and can cover a large number of ewes.

Average adult weight will vary across the breed with regional differences. Smaller hill types 75kg for Rams, 50kg for Ewes. Strong lowland types 85kg+ for Rams, 65kg+ for Ewes.
